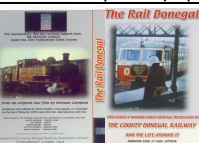

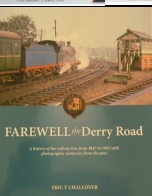

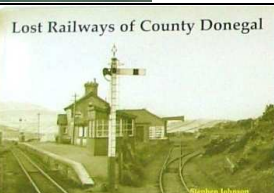


Farewell The Derry Road by Eric T Challoner

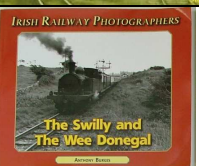


Lost Railways of County Donegal

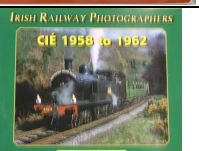

A 64-page volume on the railways of County Donegal with a new set of photographs from the collection of both the author and Dr G R Siviour. Generous selection of photos of the CDR railcars, stock and locomotives as well as detail of the stations. There are fewer of the Swilly as only the part of the line was operational in the 1950s, from Derry to Bunrana and Letterkenny is covered in this work. An absolute must for all fans of the Donegal lines.

Another 64-page volume intended as a sequel to Chasing the Flying Snail. This book covers CIE across the whole of Ireland with examples from Cork to Clones, Dublin, Limerick, and Cavan, not forgetting the Valencia and Kenmare lines. Photos, mainly locos with their trains in interesting locations. A variety of locos are covered from Maedhbh to the humblest shunter, railcars, diesel-electrics and even the turf-burner.z

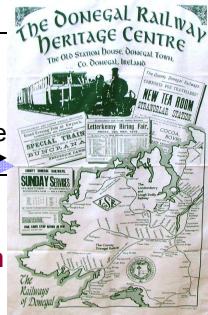


Railways In Ireland, Part Two: by Martin Bairstow.
